Vide the present appeal, the appellant has challenged the judgment dated 02.06.2017 whereby ld.trial court has convicted the appellant for the offence u/s 23 of the Juvenile Justice Act, 2000 and sentence order dated 26.07.2017 whereby the ld. trial court has sentenced the convict to undergo imprisonment for a period of two months and compensation of Rs.2,50,000/- to be paid to the victim, in default of which, appellant to further undergo simple imprisonment for one month for the mental trauma

caused to the victim/child.

Alongwith appeal, an application u/s 389 Cr.P.C for suspension of sentence and grant of bail pending decision of appeal has been filed.

Heard.

Since the appeal is going to take a considerable time for disposal and having regard to grounds set out in the appeal, the application filed by convict/appellant is allowed and sentence order dated 26.07.2017 is suspended during the pendency of this appeal subject to the appellant furnishing personal bond in the sum of Rs. 10,000/- with one surety in the like amount to the satisfaction of this court. Bail bond filed. Same stands accepted.

Ld.Addl.PP for state accepts notice on behalf of respondent and admits regarding receipt of copy of appeal and documents.

Put up on 26.09.2017 for arguments.
